Thank you for your continued trust in Bridgeport Catholic Academy. We pride our school on maintaining a safe environment for all students and families, and we strongly enforce all state and local health requirements set in place.

All new and returning students at Bridgeport Catholic Academy are required to meet the health requirements set forth by the State of Illinois and the Archdiocese of Chicago. To ensure the safety and well-being of all students, the following documentation must be submitted to the school office by the designated deadline.

Birth Record, Medical Examination, and Immunization Requirements

Preschool Students:

- **Birth Certificate:** Parents/guardians enrolling a child must provide a certified copy of the child's birth certificate as proof of identity and age. The school will make a copy for its records and promptly return the original to the parent/guardian.
- **Physical Examination & Immunization Records:** A current, up-to-date physical examination and immunization record must be submitted. Parents must complete the yes/no questionnaire on the back of the form and sign and date it. Any incomplete forms will be returned and must be resubmitted to the school office promptly.
- **Medical Form:** Complete immunization records must be documented on the official medical form and signed by a licensed healthcare provider.
- **Required Immunizations for Preschool Entry:**
 - 4 doses of DTaP
 - 3 doses of Polio
 - 4 doses of Hib
 - 3 doses of Hepatitis B
 - 1 dose of MMR
 - 1 dose of Varicella
 - 4 doses of Pneumococcal

Please note that students who do not have the proper documentation on file may be excluded from school until all requirements are met.



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Birth Record, Medical Examination, and Immunization Requirements

Kindergarten Students:

- **Birth Certificate:** Parents/guardians enrolling a child must provide a certified copy of the child's birth certificate as proof of identity and age. The school will make a copy for its records and promptly return the original to the parent/guardian.
- **Physical Examination & Immunization Records:** A current, up-to-date physical examination and immunization record must be submitted. Parents must complete the yes/no questionnaire on the back of the form and sign and date it. Any incomplete forms will be returned and must be resubmitted to the school office promptly.
- **Medical Form:** Complete immunization records must be documented on the official medical form and signed by a licensed healthcare provider.
- **Required Immunizations for Kindergarten Entry:**
 - 5 doses of DTaP
 - 4 doses of Polio
 - 4 doses of Hib
 - 3 doses of Hepatitis B
 - 2 doses of MMR
 - 2 doses of Varicella
 - 4 doses of Pneumococcal
- **Vision Examination:** A vision exam must be completed and signed by a licensed optometrist. The examination must be conducted within 12 months prior to the first day of school.
- **Dental examination:** A dental examination must be completed and signed by a licensed dentist by May 15th of the current school year. This form must be dated within 18 months of the May 15th deadline.

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Medical Examination and Immunization Requirements

2nd Grade Students:

- **Dental Examination:** A dental examination must be completed and signed by a licensed dentist by **May 15th** of the current school year. The exam must be dated within 18 months of the May 15th deadline.

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Medical Examination and Immunization Requirements

6th Grade Students

- **Current up to date physical examination and immunization records:** Parents must complete the yes/no questionnaire on the back of the form and sign and date. Any form with this section not completed will be returned to complete and sent back to the school office immediately.
- Complete immunization records list documented on the Medical form signed by a doctor.
- Students entering 6th grade must show proof of the following vaccinations.
 - 1 dose of Tdap vaccine
 - 1 dose of Meningitis vaccine
- **Dental examination:** A dental examination must be completed and signed by a licensed dentist by May 15th of the current school year. This form must be dated within 18 months of the May 15th deadline.
